# Career and Technical Education ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES

# **Recommended Criteria for Determining Students**

- 1. The student's career pathway aligns with his/her EDP.
- 2. The student has completed a vocational assessment and academic records indicate aptitude and interest in a chosen career area.
- The student has an acceptable attendance record.
- 4. The student has previously demonstrated competency in related courses.

### **Enrollment Process**

- 1. The student will complete the enrollment and the medical release form for the Career and Technical Education programs and obtain a parent or quardian signature
- 2. The student will give the enrollment form to their high school counselor
- 3. The high school counselor will
  - forward the white and yellow copies of the enrollment form to the educating district by May 1
  - maintain the pink copy for the sending district's records
  - give the gold copy to the student

### **Timeline**

January / February Schools make available student enrollment information

April (3rd week) Students make site visits to Career and Technical Education programs. A tentative

schedule is made available to counselors.

May 1 Applications are due to the school counselors.

May (2nd week) Principals determine enrollments and develop tentative recommendations for

programs. Initial program slot allocation is made available to all districts.

June If necessary, principals adjust the program and finalize recommendations

for programs.

August Final Adjustments made for fall classes.
