Co-op Work-Based Learning Placements

What is Co-op?

Co-op is on-the-job training at a work site during school hours. It is designed to give students a supervised, practical application of work experience based on previously learned skills in a related industry.

Benefits of Co-op

For students: It provides a safe learning/working environment for the student to demonstrate skills and verify their chosen career pathway.

Requirements for Co-op

- 12th grade student AND at least 17 years old
- On track to graduate and passing all classes
- Acceptable school attendance records
- Availability in student's schedule
- Educational Development Plan (EDP) relates to desired industry
- Taking a class related to the Co-op during 12th grade, or in a previous year
- Reliable transportation to and from the Co-op site
- Responsible and respectful attitude and a willingness to learn
- If placement is CTE related, must be at least a concentrator
- Willing to be a part of the Jobs for Michigan's Graduates program
